Sunday, October 28, 2018

The Montreal Holocaust Museum expresses its deepest condolences to the families of the victims of the horrific massacre which took place at the Tree of Life Synagogue in Pittsburgh. We stand in solidarity with Jewish communities around the world, as we are reminded, once again, of the consequences of antisemitism and hate. Innocent people gathered in prayer, on a Shabbat morning, were targeted for their practice as Jews.

Our Museum strives to teach all about the history of the Holocaust, and to prevent prejudice, hate and indifference. When hate is legitimized, when we allow the constant disparaging of minorities through speech, hateful acts follow. We, and all people of good faith, must redouble our efforts. The losses are too great and too frequent. There is much to do to heal the world.
