



## INSTRUCTIONS

1. This activity can be completed individually or in groups (3 people per group).
2. Starting with the [History of the Holocaust timeline](#), each group/student selects an event from the timeline.
3. This activity is made up of 3 tasks that can be completed individually by each member of the group, and one task where students compile their research.

<b>Task 1: Contextualize the event</b>	<b>Task 2: Analyze an artefact related to the event</b>	<b>Task 3: Analyze a testimony related to the event</b>	<b>Task 4: Compiling your research</b>
Starting from the <a href="#">History of the Holocaust</a> page, present the social, economic and political context that allows us to understand the event, as well as the consequences of this event on the Jewish population.  See Appendix 1.	On the <a href="#">Objects of Interest</a> page, or on our <a href="#">app</a> , select a theme that is related to the event. Choose an artefact from amongst the different options available.  With the help of Appendix 2, analyze the artefact in order to gain a better understanding of how it is related to the event.	On the <a href="#">Holocaust Life Stories</a> page, the <a href="#">Building New Lives</a> page, or our <a href="#">Youtube channel</a> , or on our <a href="#">app</a> , select a theme or a place that is related to the chosen event. Select a survivor or a place from amongst the suggested options.  With the help of Appendix 3, analyze the survivor's testimony to gain a better understanding of how it is connected to the event.	Appendix 4 allows you to compile the research conducted during Tasks 1 to 3, in order to gain a better understanding of the chosen event and its impact on the Jewish population.

4. In addition to the activities above, you can :
  - Write a text that presents the event, the artefact and testimony excerpts that allow us to better understand the Holocaust and its impact on Jewish life.
  - Prepare an oral presentation of their research.
  - Enrich your research by exploring other [events](#), [artefacts](#) and [survivor testimonies](#).
  - Create a collaborative timeline by compiling the information gathered by each group in their analysis chart (Appendix 4).
